### The Source of Hong Kong Technical Education from Public Repositories

*Abstract:*

After Dr. Sun Yat Sin had received western medical education in Hong Kong, the development of western technology in Hong Kong was advanced in a rapid rate, such as the use of electricity, telecommunication, wireless communication and etc.. New machineries and materials were used in infra-structures such as reclamation, reservoir, road and building. To complete these works, technical education was no doubt the means to this end. The speaker had spent his time in various publicly assessed repositories digging out relevant materials in order to find out the source of Hong Kong technical education. He will share his findings using the forgotten private-owned Li Shing Scientific and Industrial College and the Government Hong Kong Technical Institute.

## The VPET Repository in Hong Kong

VPET Repository is a web-based platform to collect and search digital materials relating to Vocational and Professional Education and Training (VPET) in Hong Kong. It is funded by the Quality Enhancement Support Scheme (QESS) of Education Bureau on the project of “The establishment of a VPET repository for collection of materials relating to Vocational and Professional Education and Training in Hong Kong.”

VPET Repository consists of 3 parts: VPET Resources and Tools Bank, VPET Bibliography Database, and Other Online Resource Banks Worldwide.

VPET Resources and Tools Bank collected more than 400 resources and tools on the history of VPET in Hong Kong, Qualifications Framework, VPET Pedagogies, Manpower Surveys, Statistical Reports, VPET Subject Guide, and Occupation Dictionary.

VPET Bibliography Database contains more than 686 bibliographic records of publications and research outputs pertaining to VPET in Hong Kong. Among them, 277 records have access to full text. VPET Bibliography Database collection includes: research reports, journal articles, conference papers, theses, book chapters, and monographs.

“Other Online Resource Banks Worldwide” provides access to resources on VPET beyond Hong Kong.
